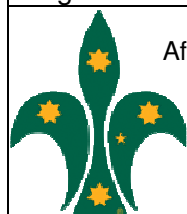

Green Challenge High Ropes Course- Add \$15.00 pp



A new opportunity is available at the Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary for students in the areas of health, physical Education, personal Development, Outdoor Recreation, Recreation Studies and those looking for a fun day out. The Green Challenge (GC) is a High Ropes Adventure Challenge Course that is situated within the Sanctuary itself. The course comprises of up to 65 elements including 2 Tarzan swings and a 17m high flying fox. Please note to do this activity you must be able to reach 160cm with arms stretched above head and feet flat on ground.

Aboriginal Appreciation Experience – Add \$5.00 pp

CWS is please to be able to promote an engaging outdoor presentation by Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary's own Aboriginal Dance Troup. Some of the cultural appreciation topic include:

- Bush tucker
- Hunting and gathering – tools and weapons
- Dwellings
- Music and Dance
- Dreamtime (understanding dreaming)



Some objectives include- Appreciate differences in culture; Show respect for different socio-cultural backgrounds; Practise languages by speaking aboriginal words; Understanding Aboriginal culture; making links between Indigenous Australians as part of Australia's History. Presentations will be held outside at our Aboriginal Dance Area.

Highly Recommended additional activities (subject to availability)

Threatened Species Treasure Trail- Students learn about Australian threatened and endangered wildlife housed at CWS. Groups are given their first clue which engages them in a series of clues that leads them around the threatened wildlife enclosures in the park. Along the way students learn about threats to native wildlife and how we are making a difference. **Add \$2.00 per person/per program**

Koala Photo Opportunity:

Add \$6.00 pp

Students get the opportunity to hold a koala and have their photo taken. Photos are 6 x 4 inch colour portraits.

Behind the Scenes Tour
