Dear Parents &/or Caregivers,

Thank you for your interest in Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary's Camp Crocodile Holiday Program.

During their visit with us, your child will have a great time. Each camp out includes:

- Koala presentation pat and chat
- Aboriginal dance performance
- A photo of your child with the Aboriginal dancers or Wildlife photo
- Guided spotlighting walk
- Early morning Lorriquet Feeding
- A safe and secure camping environment
- Dinner, supper and breakfast
- Guided tour of naturally wild nocturnal house
- Crocodile spotting
- Kangaroo feeding at night when they are most active
- Interactive wildlife presentation

Please read the following very carefully. Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary staff will do their very best to ensure the safety of your child. We aim to provide your child with a safe working environment. All staff possess relevant qualifications and first-aid officers are readily available on site.

Once you have read this information please complete the relevant Booking Form, sign and return to us as soon as possible with payment*. **It is essential we have this information as early as possible.**

Important information

Age;

- Please note age restrictions apply. Eco Ranger Holiday Program is open to children aged 6-12 years inclusive.

Cost;

- \$74 per child.

Times;

- Start – 4.00pm.
- Finish – 8.00am.

Food provided includes;

- Dinner Served approximately 6.30pm. Chicken Burgers, Chips and condiments
- Supper Served approximately 8.00pm. Consists of Muffins & hot chocolate
- Breakfast Cereal, toast, fresh fruit, fruit juice, hot chocolate and condiments

CWS can accommodate most dietary requirements. Please let us know of your child's needs.

Required by all participating children;

- Adequate protection for all weather conditions including a hooded raincoat for wet weather.
- We recommend children wear warm clothes
- Must wear enclosed footwear, either boots or running shoes.
- Sleeping bag, mat/airbed (no mattresses) and pillow
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, facecloth, soap, hairbrush etc
- Insect repellent
- Change of clothes
- Sleepwear
- A torch
- Camera can be brought, however CWS will not be liable for any damage or loss.
- Must be signed in by a parent or caregiver at the main entrance to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary.
- Must be signed out and picked up at the end of their session time 8.00am (NO LATER) from the main entrance to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary. Supervision and safety can not be guaranteed after this time.

Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary does not provide shower facilities. Please ensure your child has a shower before arrival..

Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary will provide the following:

- Tents. We provide 2-person dome tents, please indicate if you would like certain children to share tents
- Catering (dinner, supper, breakfast)
- Photo
- Competent reliable staff with the relevant qualifications

CWS staff will be responsible for escorting students to the toilets at all times/ Children are to wake a staff member at night if they need to go to the toilet .CWS staff will have a first aid kit and a telecommunications device with them at all times. It is our aim to provide a safe, educational and fun experience for your child, please contact us if you have any further questions.

Booking Procedure

- Camp Crocodile must be paid 24 hours in advance of the booked night
- We **MUST** receive the Camp Crocodile Booking form 48 hours in advance before the night.
- Places are limited. We suggest booking asap to secure your booking
- We can take tentative bookings, however we must receive payment and booking within 48 hours or the place will be offered to other interested parties.

From the Teachers, Keepers and Creatures.

*Camp Crocodile Holiday Program may be cancelled if we receive insufficient numbers of bookings. The program requires a minimum of 12 participants on any given camp. Should a day be cancelled, you will be notified in advance to organise a change of day.

Cancellation Policy: If your child is unable to attend Camp Crocodile for what ever reason, notice must be given to CWS no later than 10am on the same day as your booking. Failure to advise a cancellation by 10am that day will result in a 100% cancellation fee, however If you decide to select another night, there will be no charge.

CURRUMBIN WILDLIFE SANCTUARY'S ECO RANGERS - LIABILITY RELEASE

In consideration of the services and facilities of the Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary (hereinafter "the Sanctuary") being provided to the camper/participant, through the Sanctuary's agents, officers, employees, volunteers, trustees and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on behalf of the National Trust of Queensland, Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary (hereinafter collectively referred to as "CWS"), I AGREE TO RELEASE AND DISCHARGE CWS, on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, guardians, heirs, assigns, personal representatives and estate as follows:

I ACKNOWLEDGE the inherent risks involved in all outdoor activities and camping, some of which may include physical exertion for which I may not be prepared; the variable terrain of CWS; the inherent unreliability of weather conditions or weather extremes subject to sudden and unexpected change and evacuation difficulties; and the unreliability of light and wildlife, particularly in so far as these conditions may affect the organisation, management and supervision of groups including groups of children, and I ACKNOWLEDGE that such risks may result in physical or psychological injury, paralysis, death, or damage to property belonging to me, CWS and/or to third parties. I realise that these risks cannot be eliminated entirely and may be contributed to by the negligence of other campers or participants, visitors and other persons and my own negligence. I understand that there are also unforeseeable accidents which may occur and I assume all risk in relation to such accidents. I agree that there are possible accidents which I cannot foresee and that CWS cannot foresee and I assume all risk associated with these. I agree to pay attention to the condition of the terrain and to my surroundings at all times and to advise CWS staff of any condition of which I am aware or become aware which might reasonably result in an increased risk to myself or others. I have read and agreed to abide by all CWS rules. I agree that if any CWS staff make a specific request or give an instruction to me, I will comply. I agree that the jobs of CWS staff are difficult and that they seek wherever reasonably possible to create a safe environment by giving adequate warnings and/or instructions. I agree that CWS staff cannot be aware of a participant/camper's fitness or abilities.

I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks which exist by reason of my participation in camping, use of CWS equipment, facilities or grounds (the "activities"). My participation in these activities is purely voluntary and I elect to participate in spite of the risks.

I agree to assume all risk of personal injury, including paralysis and death which may occur while I am in the Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary. I hereby voluntarily release, and forever discharge and covenant not to sue or take action against CWS or the National Trust of Queensland, its directors or trustees, officers, employees, volunteers, insurers and agents (the 'Releasees'), from all liability for any such personal injury which I may incur and any and all claims, demands or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in these activities.

1.4 In the event of any claim, demand or cause of action made against CWS, the National Trust of Queensland, its directors or trustees, officers, employees, volunteers, insurers and agents, by the undersigned or by any minor over who I have supervisory responsibility at the facilities of CWS (whether or not the undersigned is physically present at the time of the occurrence of any injury, damage or loss), I agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the said Releasees, including the payment of reasonable legal fees and costs, for any claim arising in whole or in part from alleged negligent action or breach of duty or breach of contract or inaction on the part of any Releasee.

1.5 I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer whilst participating in the activities, in the alternative I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I certify that I have no medical, emotional and/or physical conditions which could interfere with my safety in these activities, in the alternative I am willing to assume, and bear the cost of, all risks which may be created, directly or indirectly by any such condition.

1.6 I understand that this Camping and Participation Agreement, release, acknowledgment of risk and indemnity agreement includes my claims for personal injury, including death, based in total or in part upon the negligent action or inaction of CWS, the National Trust of Queensland, its directors or trustees, officers, employees, volunteers, insurers and agents ('Releasees')

1.7 By signing this document I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my camping or participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a law suit against the CWS and any of the named Releasees.

1.8 I understand that this Release is a contract. I sign it of my own freewill. I also understand that this contract is severable; that if any part of it is held by a court of law to be unenforceable, the rest shall survive.
