- Pay a joining fee of \$60.00.
- Voluntarily offer my services with a clear understanding that there will be no monetary compensation or guarantee of employment.
- Endeavour to be prompt and regular in my Volunteer service, by committing to minimum of one shift per week.
- Always notify the Volunteer Co-ordinator or Duty Volunteer if I will be absent due to illness, and pre-advise absence when taking holidays.
- Readily accept on-going training and supervision.
- Have a helpful, co-operative and positive attitude at all times in communicating with all visitors to the Sanctuary, Management, Staff and other Volunteers.
- Adhere to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary policies and procedures and the Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary Volunteer Handbook.
- Ensure that the correct colour pants or shorts are worn with the CWS provided shirt and wide brimmed hat, and that strong shoes are worn at all times.
- Complete an exit form upon leaving the Volunteer program if my commitments cannot be maintained, and return my issued shirt, badge and hat to the Volunteer Co-ordinator.
- Be prepared to enjoy my time at the Sanctuary, meet new friends and engage in some great social activities.
