



# CAMP CROCODILE

Dear leader,

Thank you for your recent enquiry about the Camp Crocodile program at Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary. This pack includes information about camping here at the Sanctuary,

## ITINERARY

The following events will take place throughout your Camp Crocodile experience:

- A photograph of each student holding a live Saltwater Crocodile
- Aboriginal Dance performance
- Guided tour of the Sanctuary by torchlight (torches provided by Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary)
- Crocodile spot-lighting
- Kangaroo feeding
- Guided tour of Naturally Wild
- Wildlife Presentation (in our education centre, featuring a range of live animals including mammals, reptiles, birds and amphibians)
- Early morning wild lorikeet feeding
- Dinner, supper, breakfast
- Full day entry to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary  
(Option A – arrive at the Sanctuary on the morning of your sleepover and depart at 8.00am the following day.  
Option B – arrive 5.00pm on the evening of your sleepover and spend the following day at the Sanctuary at your leisure.)



## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Prices and dates:

- Due to council regulations, Camp Crocodile runs on Friday and Saturday evenings only.
- Children: \$74 – including day admission before / after camp, all activities, meals and tents.
- Adults: \$84 – (one free adult with every ten paying children).

### Booking Procedure:

- **10% deposit is required within 21 days of receiving this letter.**
- **Balance is payable 14 days prior to arrival date**
- Permission forms to be returned to Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary no less than 48 hours prior to your arrival.
- Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary should also be informed of any medical conditions of any of the participants no less than 48 hours prior to your arrival.
- Please refer to *Payment Details* section of the permission forms for further information and cancellation procedure.

### Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary will provide the following:

- Tents (as required, see above)
- Guide (to stay over with group. Will remain with group from 5.00pm on the afternoon of your arrival until 8.00am the next morning.)
- Catering (dinner, supper, breakfast)
- Evening program (see attached itinerary)

### It is recommended that Camp Crocodile participants should bring:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, facecloth, soap, hairbrush etc (see attached protocols for shower usage)
- Hat and sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Change of clothes
- Sleepwear
- Cameras and electronic equipment can be brought, however, this is to remain the decision and responsibility of the supervisory adult / camp coordinator.



## **ACCOMPANYING ADULT PROTOCOLS FOR CAMP CROCODILE**

- The term 'accompanying adult' refers to teachers, staff of the organisation where the students are from, scout masters and any other adults who are attending the camp whose participation has been organised by the visiting institution.
- Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary are responsible for the movement of the students whilst in Sanctuary grounds and for the program of activities throughout the duration of the camp. Accompanying adults should not deviate from this program and should liaise with the CWS representative at all times.
- Accompanying adults are ultimately responsible for the health and safety of the students in their care. CWS will provide qualified, professional and experienced staff to ensure a well-organised, prepared, quality experience for students and accompanying adults.
- Accompanying adults will be required to assist with the coordination and movement of students and will at all times be responsible for the management of the students (specifically behaviour).
- Accompanying adults must communicate any medical, behavioural or other conditions held by any child or accompanying adult in case of an emergency.
- Accompanying adults are responsible for the administration of any medication.
- CWS staff will have a first aid kit and a telecommunications device with them at all times.

- Accompanying adults and CWS staff will be responsible for escorting students to the toilets at all times. At no time should students leave the group without an adult. This includes during the night. Students should wake an adult if they need to visit a toilet.
- Showers are available for the use of adults only. If an adult requires the use of the shower they must see CWS staff, advise of their movement and preferably wait until after the students have retired. They are for use by children in emergencies only.
- CWS staff should be notified of any problems or incidents as soon as they occur.
- CWS staff are responsible for all meal preparation. Accompanying adults will be required to assist the management of students during meal times. Any special dietary requirements should be advised well before the actual camp.
- Accompanying adults responsible for children and their movement after 8.00am. At this time CWS staff will no longer be with the group.
