Patient Feed

The ongoing costs of feeding many of our wildlife patients are a large drain on the funds we have available to run our wildlife hospital. Many of our patients have to be hospitalised for many months and can have a ravenous appetite eg one Pelican can consume 140 Whiting in a week. We are currently in desperate need for the following food articles.

 - for feeding to turtles and waterbirds
